The Land

*Microclimates due to diverse slope orientations.
Deep clay and limestone soil, dominantly clay.
Altitude and significant temperature difference between night
and day produce wines that are fresh and original.*

The Grapes

*Of the 15 acres in wine grapes two-thirds are planted
in A.O.P. Ventoux: old vine Grenache, Syrah and
Marselan while the remaining third is
Merlot, Viognier and Chardonnay.
Another parcel planted in Cinsault in 2015,
adds to the rich variety of cepages.*

Wine making

*The grapes are de-stemmed and crushed followed by
natural yeast fermentation in temperature
controlled tanks. Daily pumping over at the start then
stirring of the lees. A small portion of the finest juice
is aged in barrels for six to twelve months.*

The Wine


*Five wines: two A.O.P. Ventoux reds and a rosé,
plus two Vins de Pays de Vaucluse,
one red and one white.*

Vineyard Management

*Vineyard bought in 2002, grass planted every other row and
trellis fencing at a good height. Excellent bio-diversity:
woods, streams, hedgerows, orchard and meadow. Average
yield 15 hectolitres per acre, approximately 200 hl per year.
Harvested late in the season at full maturity.*

LE DOMAINE

Dark red colour with violet highlights.
A charming burst of violet syrup and black currant liqueur on the bouquet. Splendid blend of body and fresh fruit flavours, smooth as velvet.




Twenty-five acre estate in the rolling foothills south of Mount Ventoux.

Organic vineyard with vines planted on multi-directional slopes, at an average elevation of 300 metres.



GAÏA

Deep red colour verging on purple.
A charming nose of Morello Cherry jelly, black pepper and wysteria.
Full-bodied and complex, this wine opens into floral fragrances (violet, lily, peony). Lovely fresh taste on the finish.



**LE MERLE
MERLOT**

Very dark colour, almost black. Beautiful expression of the grape variety, adding to its charm notes of cocoa, pimento and blackberry jam. Full flavoured.
Dark coloured fruit and eucalyptus.




GAÏA ROSÉ

Lovely pale strawberry colour.
This wine is a delightful expression of “garriguettes” strawberry and Comtat Venaissin cherries.
Tender and flattering without being heavy. Finish of raspberry and mint.

**LE VIOGNIER
WHITE**

Bright clear colour, pale gold with green highlights. Bouquet opens on white flowers (jasmin) then fresh fruit (peach, Williams pear). Nicely balanced taste, between potent, dense and fresh. Delicate and smooth on the finish.
